The Tommy Thompson Project - March 5, 2012

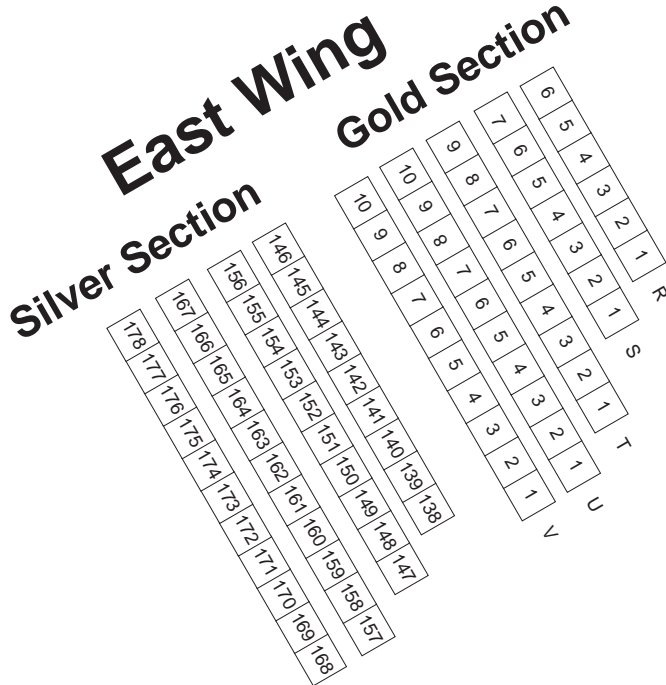

COMING TO VENTURE OUT! THE FOUR PREPS

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 6, 2012 • 7:00PM • BUENA VISTA BALLROOM



Thirty-five girls and not one boy showed up to audition for the annual Hollywood High School talent show in the fall of 1955. The next day the school bulletin pleaded for “any guys out there who can do anything” and a show business story began that sounds a little like an MGM Musical. Unable to resist such amorously appealing odds, four talented and highly motivated teenagers in the school choir literally formed a quartet overnight and stepped into the crinoline void as **THE FOUR PREPS**.

After stealing the show with hits by their idols, the Four Lads and the Crew Cuts, they quickly found themselves in demand for every kind of event imaginable. “We didn’t turn anything down,” Lead Singer Bruce Belland remembers. “We once performed on the back of a flatbed truck for the opening of a parking lot.” A short time later, Capitol Records signed them to a long term recording contract and as they say in the biz... the rest is history!

THE FOUR PREPS’ first million-seller “26 Miles (Santa Catalina) took the country by storm and soon the group was featured in LIFE magazine and on countless Ed Sullivan and American Bandstand shows. It only went on from there by performing with Bing Crosby, Frank Sinatra, Bob Hope, Louie “Satchmo” Armstrong and Rosemary Clooney. They also costarred in the movie “Gidget” with Sandra Dee and James Darren, as well as experiencing four years of special appearances on the Ozzie and Harriet Show.

And the hits continued. Big Man, Down by the Station, Lazy Summer, Got a Girl, and Gidget. All hit the charts, amassing eight gold singles and three gold albums.

After a twenty year hiatus and the loss of two original members, Bruce Belland was asked to assemble a “one shot” version of the FOUR PREPS for a PBS star-studded musical called “Magic Moments.” That show, viewed by over 65 million Americans started a groundswell of demands for a **FOUR PREPS** concert tour. The current incarnation of the Four Preps features the original lead singer, Bruce Belland, Bob Duncan (formally with the Diamonds and the Crew Cuts) Joe Dickey (of the Crew Cuts) and Skip Taylor.
