## *Manager's Corner*

*October, 2010*

This month's occupancy is 239 or 14% occupied vs. 213 the month prior and 225 the year prior.

Welcome back, if you have just arrived. Everyone is telling me as they come in how much they like the new front entry and the new hands free entry system. We are still working out some bugs in the system, trying to get everyone up to snuff on how to operate the call box when we close the gate at night. After the first trial run we added some information on the call box and that seems to have resolved any issues. Again, get your guest information in to the office, if you do not have a computer, and we will get your information input. Call Jim Gibides about any questions on the operations of the front or back gates.

The new RV spots are almost 100% booked for Jan–March. We are working now on filling those shoulder months. Woodall's reviewed the sites when completed and gave Venture Out the highest rating possible, five diamonds.

The West pool bathhouse is under construction. We expect to have it open right at the first of November. So far we have run only into one small problem and that is being resolved. We are very lucky considering how old the structure was. If anyone remembers, can you please give us the story about when there was a fire in the Bathhouse? I recall seeing that somewhere in the records over the years, but can't find it. It was very early on and we could still see the soot on the walls. We are just curious about it if you know the story; I would like to add it to VO's history.

**All classes at the West pool are asked to join the regularly scheduled classes at the East Pool. It is not possible to fold all the different classes into a new schedule. The East pool schedule remains the same. Please do not try to have classes during the regularly scheduled lap swimming hours. We have many lap swimmers and more coming back and they do take that time up. With luck we only have a month of this and then everyone is back to their normal routines.**

The Condo Board will hold a work session on October 19<sup>th</sup> regarding the Tennis and Bocce projects. This will be held at the Oasis at 9:00 a.m. Since we opened our original bids, we have gotten some subsequent numbers and so we are looking forward to this meeting to share our information with you.

The regular Condo Board meeting will be held Thursday the 21<sup>st</sup> at 9:00 a.m.

I'm sure all of you who use the web site, will be happy to know that after more than ten years, we are now re-doing this site and working to make it more user friendly. We have employed a web site designer that has done many large projects here in the valley. It will be more interactive and hopefully he will be able to finally find a way that the sales and rental forum can be easier to use.

The Resident Guide will be out soon, when it arrives, we will notify you. Please be sure to pick this up. Every year, it becomes more important as we try to put information in it that is really critical to Venture Out operations and any changes over the year. This year's focus, as you might guess, is the new front gate and the policy and procedures for issuing and using the stickers. This is not yet in the CC & R's but will be added when the Board returns.

Speaking of the CC & R's one really big job this year that the Governing Documents Committee is working on is a re-statement of the CC & R's. The last time this was done was in 1991 so it's been twenty years and long overdue. The Board authorized legal counsel this summer to review the CC & R's and re-organize them into a more user friendly document. They also asked them to make sure that the documents were reviewed for any changes in State or Federal Law that we may have missed over the years. Changes in State Law seem to come every year and it becomes quite the chore to keep this up and stay on top of every little thing they can throw at us. The most cumbersome part of this is that in the past several years, the Arizona Legislature has passed laws that changed our voting requirements for amendments and bylaws and they are NOT consistent. Once the Governing Documents Committee reviews this, copies will be distributed to all residents so that you can read and review it yourself. A restatement does require a vote of the residents. If we have no major issues with this re-write, we do expect this to be a ballot issue this year. It's also a great cure for insomnia.

Just like spotting the first robins of spring... I saw some Pickle Ball players out this morning. The next season is already upon us.

Want to see an interesting natural phenomenon? Check out the palm tree in front of 521 Merlin. A cactus is growing right out of its trunk!






