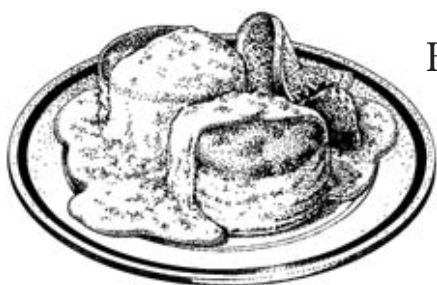

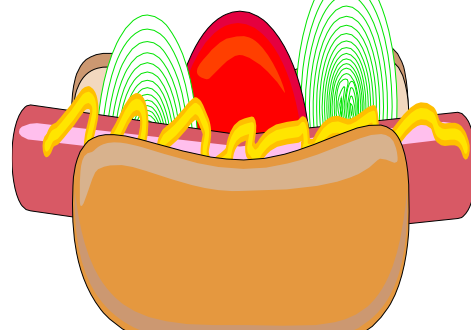

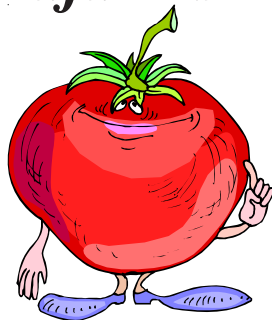

Manager's Corner

August, 2011

This month's occupancy is 185 or 10% vs. 196 the month prior and 184 the year prior. There are nine renters in the property.

As most everyone on site knows, I was forced to cancel our palm tree trimmer's contract for his failure to perform his contractual obligations. It's not a step I enjoy taking, but I really had no choice in the matter. Fortunately we were able to get our second bidder, to come in on relatively short notice and pick up where he left off. So far so good, this trimmer is doing a great job of cleaning up after himself and not leaving a mess behind. Thank you for your understanding and patience in this matter.

The East Pool is scheduled to be re-plastered this week and should be filling by the end of the week. Once the water is balanced and warms up a bit, we will re-open for business.

Road work this summer is split between repairs and later seal coat. We won't seal coat until after the palm tree trimmers have completed their work. Striping is the last thing we do and that will take place this October. You will see some small projects being done this summer... tennis courts 7 & 8 will be resurfaced, some concrete walks and parking areas are going in. Additional pavers will be added for bike parking, on the East side of the Center next to the post office and next to the Library. Street light poles have been painted and the lighting contractor has completed the retro fit of the property for the high efficiency lighting.

We've had a few lot owners forget what the \$65.00 assessment was for. This was to move transformers that SRP was NOT going to move, but we asked to be moved to benefit the property owners. SRP is still out there working on the survey and we hope to see this completed sometime this year. I think we were very lucky to get the work done this year as Mr. Areghini who was so instrumental in finally stepping in and solving our problems at VO is no longer with SRP. I also want to complement one of SRP's employee's, Linda Fitzhugh. Many of you know Linda, the lanky brunette Designer that spent the better part of the year out here, figuring out how and where to move all these transformers. During our major power failure last month, Linda left work once she was allowed to and came directly to Venture Out. She walked door to door, checking on residents to make sure they had vacated their homes. She managed to find one lady that we missed when we went out earlier. Linda brought her to the center and we got her sent off in the last car out to a hotel for the night. That was service above and beyond what one would expect from any outside contractor, much less a major utility company. We can't say enough positives about how Linda has treated Venture Out residents and the care that she has given this community.

During this excessive heat, we have had some residents go to the hospital for heat exhaustion because their A/C's were not working properly. **IF YOUR AC GOES DOWN**, notify the office or security and we will keep the center open for you. We have recliners and a couch in the Sonoran café and in the past we have had residents stay overnight in there due to HVAC or power failures. Don't try to tough it out in your home; this kind of heat can kill.

If you haven't done so already, check out our new web site and on the web site is a direct link to our FACEBOOK page. We post more regular photos and videos on the FACEBOOK page to try to keep everyone abreast with the daily news at Venture Out. Very soon, Teresa and the Activity office will use it as well to remind everyone of the events that are coming up, when something sells out etc. I hope we can get some great little home videos on there as well. Both services are being well received. The FACEBOOK page is getting about 250 views per week and that is increasing each week.

Again, stay safe in this weather and please help us by checking on your neighbors and alerting us if you think something is wrong. Always evacuate to the Center in the event of a major emergency where staff will meet to help you.

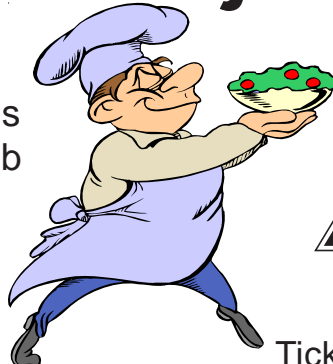

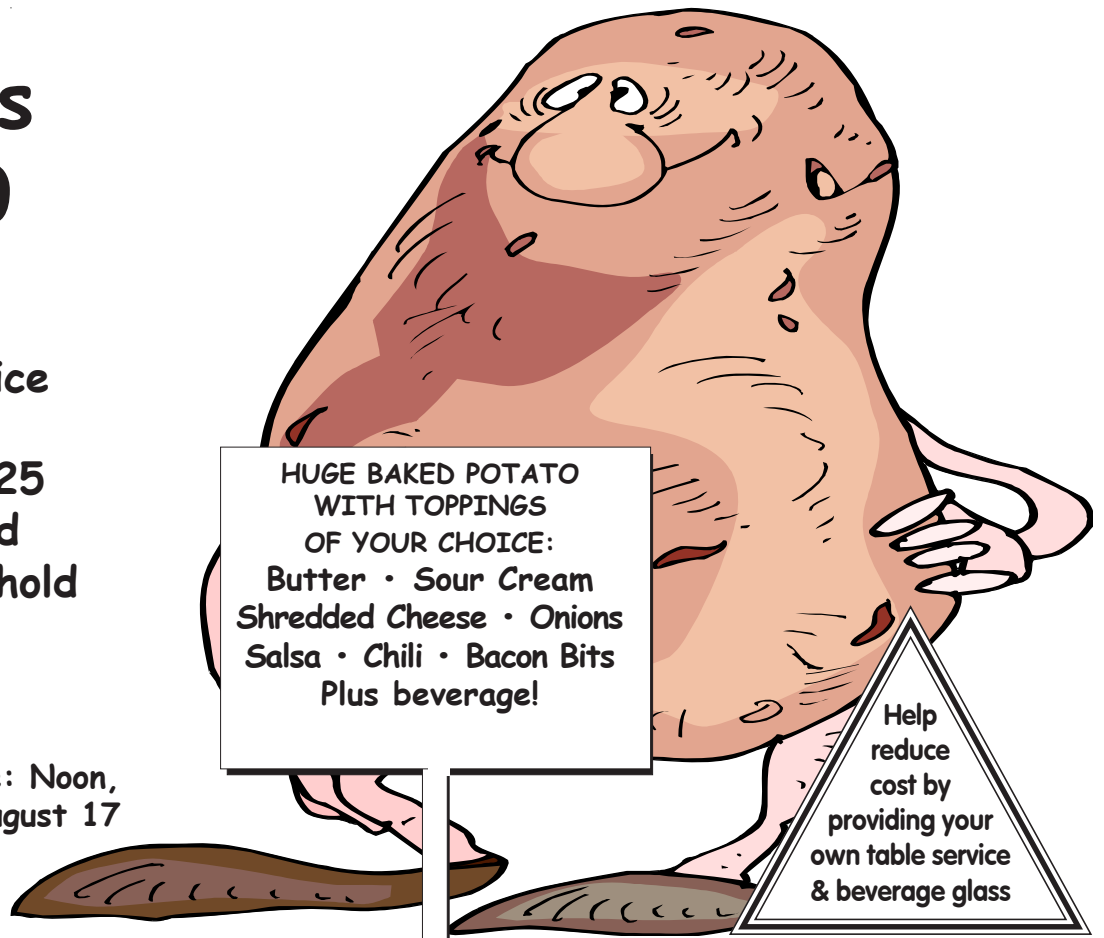
