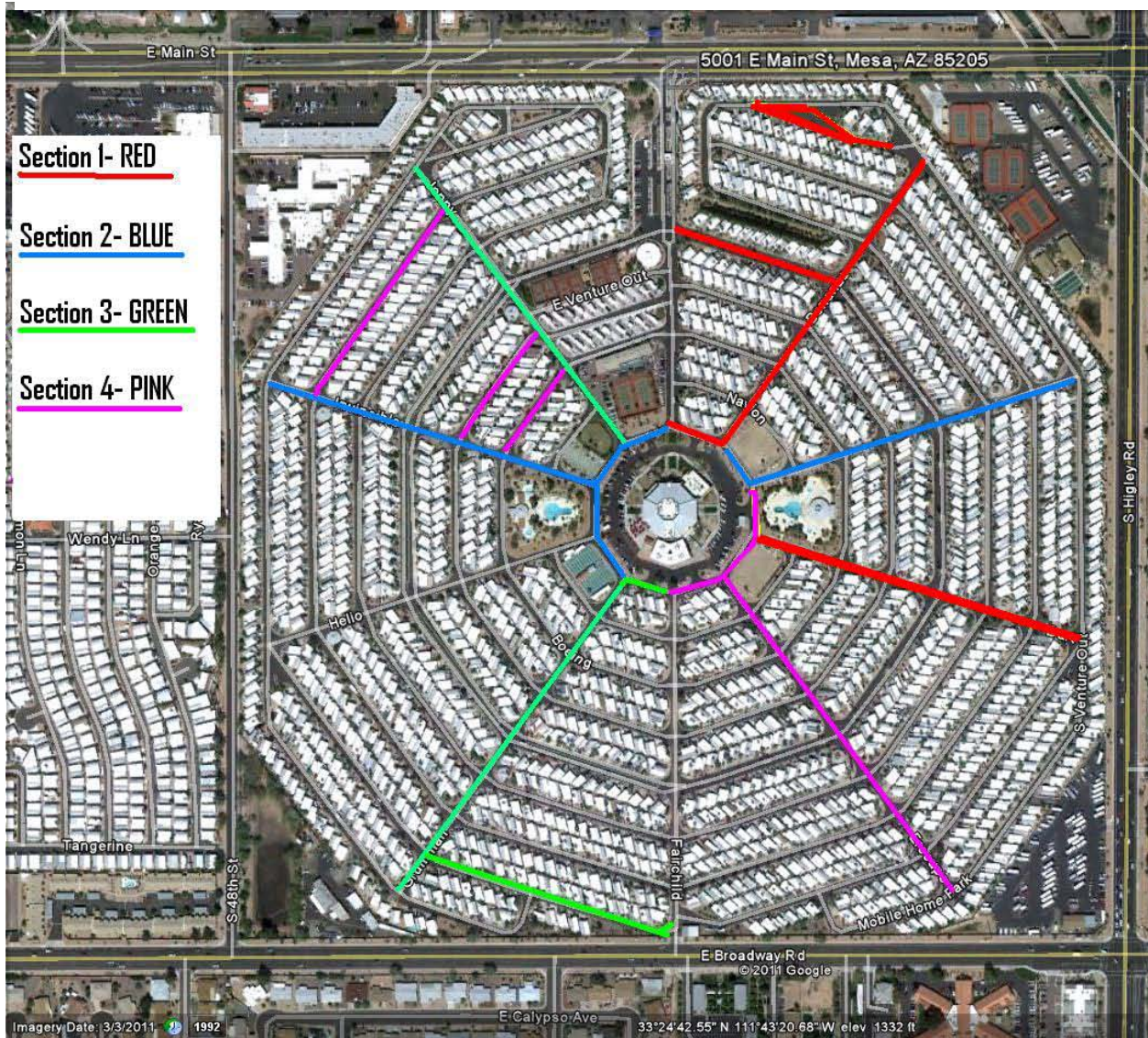

# *Manager's Corner*

*September, 2011*

This month's occupancy is 169 or 9% vs. 185 the month prior and 188 the year prior. There are nine renters in the property.

The palm tree trimmers are almost done and I think we can all agree that they have done a very good job for coming in with almost no notice and picking up behind the last contractor. We have found them to be very good to work with and they are doing the best job they can to get us finished in a timely fashion. I've even had some residents call in and compliment them, so that is very nice.

The East Pool was re-opened the third week of August. We had a few areas that we wanted them to fix prior to re-opening. I hope you all like the finished product.

Work is now commencing on concrete pads around the park, including a tennis hitting cage, some steps down to the Library and some parking spaces just west of the Sewing Room.

Tennis Courts 7 & 8 will be resurfaced and 5 & 6 will require some repairs after the rubber surface was caught in a windstorm and flipped back. These will be done the last week of August.

Seal coating the streets will commence in September. Striping will take place in October. While you might see some areas that look like they are wearing and could use additional seal coat, we are not applying it as often as we used to, as we have been told that the buildup of the seal coat can be the cause of the black dust, so we are letting it wear down more than we have in the past.

This past week the Condo Board met via telephone conference and authorized the architect to design one additional court for Bocce. The architect came to a similar conclusion as we had in the past, that to touch or in any way build into the retention basin was very expensive. The option for six courts turned in the north, south direction is also at this time not being considered due to the expense. Once the residents return, the drawings will be presented to the club and we hope everyone will be satisfied with the solution for this area. It is simply landlocked and our options are limited.

We are also moving along on the East Pool Bathhouse/Fitness design. During the Planning design sessions in the spring which were well attended by many residents, it was determined to start over with a new building at the same site. Again these drawings will be available upon the return of the residents and we are striving to have hard drawings that can be bid by Jan 1st. This project would be primarily a reserve project, in the same way as the front entry and RV's renovation.

We are so happy to have the addition of our new Chef Todd Fynan who comes to us with a great deal of experience, most notably working as a chef at both casinos and golf clubs. I sat with Teresa as we went through stacks and stacks of resumes and we feel like we were very fortunate to find Todd. I think you will see food service step up a few notches this year.

Don't forget to check out our Web pages and our Facebook page. We try to use the Facebook page for more informal communications and it is easy to post small videos as well as photos, vs. the Web site which is more structured and formal. The web sites Bulletin Board now has 142 users signed up and I have been told that most really like its new features. Don't forget you can also use it to advertise items for sale in the park. We are limiting the posters to lot owners or current renters as Karen in ADMIN has to authorize the users and she is not a full time IT person, she has many other duties. Anyone can read the bulletin board.

Finally, in closing, I have to tell you that for the first six months of operation (Jan – June) our gate system recorded 527,000 entries and exits. Considering how few problems we had with this new system, I'd consider that a pretty successful application. We are now testing medic alert systems, that the front gate system also can support. We hope to be able to offer this service to our most at risk residents. We will keep you informed about this option.

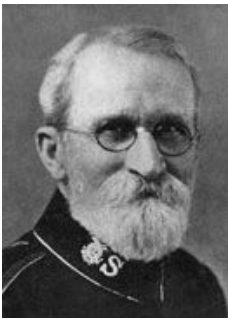

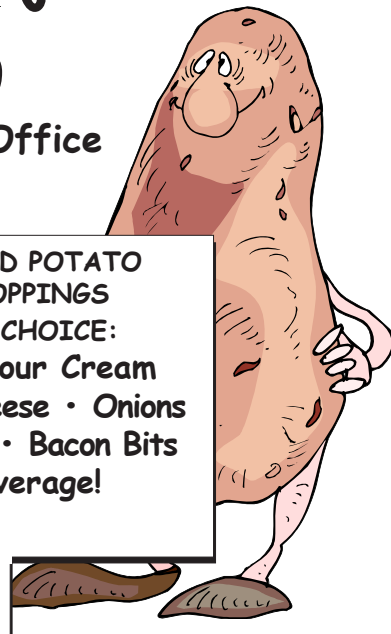

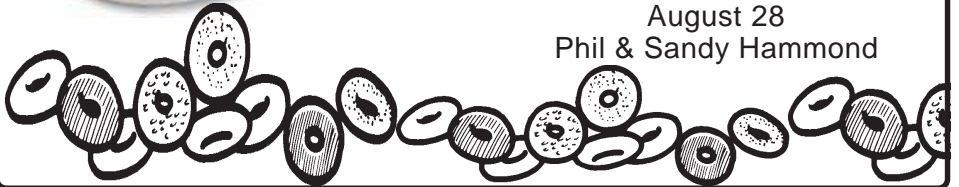
